DID YOU KNOW?

- MORE AFRICAN AMERICAN WOMEN DIE OF BREAST CANCER THAN CAUCASIAN WOMEN
- HISPANIC WOMEN MAY HAVE A HIGHER NUMBER OF BARRIERS TO GETTING MAMMOGRAMS THAN WOMEN OF OTHER ETHNICITIES
- WOMEN WITH A FAMILY HISTORY AND WHO ARE AGE 40+ ARE AT A HIGHER RISK FOR DEVELOPING BREAST CANCER
- EVERY 2 MINUTES A WOMAN IS DIAGNOSED WITH BREAST CANCER AND 1 WOMAN WILL DIE OF BREAST CANCER EVERY 13 MINUTES
- BREAST CANCER IS THE SECOND LEADING CAUSE OF CANCER DEATH AMONG WOMEN
