DID YOU KNOW...

- In Tulsa County there were 157 deaths due to overdose and there were 1,749 individuals admitted to drug treatment programs in 2017.
- According to 2018 Oklahoma Drug Threat Assessment Report, prescription opioids are listed as the top drug threat in Tulsa county, followed by methamphetamine and heroin.
- Oklahoma leads the nation in non-medical use of pain medicine, and has the highest percentage of individuals as young as 12 years old who use medications for non-medical reasons.
- On average, one Oklahoman dies every day from an opioid overdose.
- Commonly abused drugs in Oklahoma are:
 - * Cocaine
 - * Marijuana
 - * Crystal meth
 - * Prescription Drugs
